Application Process

- Complete entry application
- Complete essay based on one of the topics from the list on the previous page.
- Essay must be longer than 250 words but no more than 500 words
- Send an official school transcript with list of completed classes, grades and GPA included
- The official school transcript should show that you are also currently enrolled in classes. Must be an active student at an accredited high school
- *Home school students are not required to provide official school transcripts

Specifics

- Winner to be chosen based on criteria set by Cinch® marketing team.
- Valid entries include completed application, official school transcript with proof of GPA and class enrollment (*exception for home school students) and one completed essay question (250 to 500 words) from the list provided.
- Applications/essay questions will be available on NHSRA and Cinch websites by October 1, 2017.
