CONTESTANT DANCES



Dress Code for Dances:

- Contestants are required to wear contestant numbers at Contestant Dances
- Long pants, or pants that are at least knee length.
- Shirts do not have to be tucked in provided no skin is showing.
- Footwear is required and shoes may be open toed.
- T-shirts with SLEEVES may be worn. NO TANK TOPS, LOW CUT, CUT OFF OR MIDRIFF TOPS ARE ALLOWED. Any messages on clothing must be positive and cannot advertise alcohol, tobacco or marijuana products.
- Western boots and hats are optional. Baseball caps are acceptable. All clothing is subject to Chaperone's discretion.

Contestant Code of Conduct:

- Dancing must be appropriate and clean.
- Foul language or insubordination to directors and chaperones is grounds for rodeo disqualification.

Contestant's Guests:

- One guest per NJHFR contestant.
- Contestant: YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR GUEST'S ATTIRE AND CONDUCT!
- Contestants will be given a "Dance Guest" back number with the same number as yours. It is your responsibility to keep track of this number and your guest.
- You can be DISQUALIFIED for your guest's conduct, as well as your own.
- Guests are required to follow dress codes.
