



Personal Transportation Policy for Contestants

No Off-Road personal vehicles will be allowed on the grounds of the Events Complex during the 2019 National High School Finals Rodeo.

Definition of "Off-Road" Vehicle:

"Off-Road Vehicle" means any self-propelled vehicle that is designed or capable of traversing natural or conditioned terrain, including, but not limited to motorcycles, golf carts, dirt bikes, four and two-wheel drive all-terrain vehicles, and halftracks, but does not include these vehicles under credentials of the Events Complex use or law enforcement.

- All Rental Carts, Fire Prevention, Emergency Services or any other "official" vehicle on grounds will be credentialed by the Rental Golf Cart Provider to identify all vehicles on grounds.
- If you are caught in a non-credentialed Off-Road Vehicle on grounds of the Events Complex the Vehicle will immediately be placed in a locked containment area and returned at the end of the event.
- If an "Off-Road Vehicle" is licensed in Wyoming to drive on public roads it is allowed on Events Complex grounds for operation to and from designated rodeo performances and trade show parking areas. "Off-Road Vehicles" that are licensed and legal in other States/Provinces are NOT allowed. Exception for local rodeo traffic.
- All Rental Carts must be driven by persons 16 years of age or older and hold a valid driver's license.

Local Event Management and Law Enforcement will enforce these rules and regulations during the entire duration of the event. Non-compliance of these rules will be dealt with by local law enforcement.
