

Fall Bash Bounty Rodeo

Oklahoma hosted 10 states and over 250 Junior High and High School contestants at the Lazy E Arena for the Fall Bash Bounty Rodeo...

The 2019 Fall Bash Bounty Rodeo – an NHSRA Western Legacy Series event – enjoyed some beautiful weather and great competition November 8-10 at the fabulous Lazy E Arena in Guthrie, Oklahoma. 253 high school and junior high school rodeo contestants competed for \$10,000 added money, WCRA Exemptions, Gist All-Around buckles, and Cinch certificates. The Oklahoma High School Rodeo Association produced the event and offered “bounty” money to out of state contestants who won attended and won their event. Contestants from Texas, Colorado, Arkansas, Wyoming, Iowa, Wisconsin, Missouri, Minnesota, and Kansas competed for the bounty bonuses.

National Saddlery Co. has been the presenting sponsor of the Fall Bash Rodeo since 2015. The Fall Bash was started as a way to conclude the Oklahoma high school and junior high fall season. It has turned into much more than just two regular-season rodeos. The 2019 event was kicked off on Friday evening with extra jackpot roping events for contestants and their family members. With the Lazy E Arena as the venue, family and friends were able to enjoy rough stock and timed events simultaneously under one roof in a clean climate-controlled environment. A third covered arena, located just a few steps outside the indoor arena, created the perfect environment for calf roping events – tie-down, breakaway, ribbon roping – and goat tying. With three arenas, nearly 400 entries were run off each day in about 5 hours leaving time for contestants and their families to take in historic Guthrie, Oklahoma or be entertained in nearby Edmond, Oklahoma. Some even attended the Thoroughbred horse races at nearby Remington Park and attended evening events at the AQHA World Show in Oklahoma City.

“We were super excited that the Fall Bash was selected by NHSRA to be an inaugural Western Legacy Series event. We enjoy producing high-quality rodeos and the Lazy E Arena is too great of a facility not to share with our friends from other states. The NHSRA support helped us take the Fall Bash to a new level” explained Jeff Todd, President of the Oklahoma High School Rodeo Association NHSRA Executive Director, James Higginbotham, and Executive Board Member, Kelly Anderson from Utah, attended the Fall Bash.
