

CAMPGROUND & LODGING INFO

Welcome!

The Lancaster County Agricultural Society & Lancaster Event Center & fairgrounds staff and volunteers are very proud and excited to host the National High School Finals Rodeo in 2020 & 2021. We look forward to extending our famous "NEBRASKA NICE" welcome to each of you. Once you settle in after check in, stop by and say HOWDY to our staff and volunteers at any of our service and information desks in the campground, trade show, General Store in the stalling barn, cafes, ticket box office at front of each arena or the main LEC business office at the front of CinchTown. They will be glad to help you with any questions you may have. Please take the time to read the following information and rules. **GOOD LUCK CONTESTANTS AND HAVE FUN!!!**

CAMPGROUND INFO

PARKING: Please keep all vehicles and personal belongings within your designated campsite. All spaces are reserved and need to be available to enter at all times. You will be notified of any violation, regardless of the time of day. If the owner is unavailable, vehicles will be towed, and personal belongings will be taken to Lost and Found in the Lancaster Event Center (LEC) Business Office.

NO HORSES OR GOATS ARE ALLOWED IN CAMPGROUNDS AT ANY TIME! Pets must wear a tag with owner's name/number and be under the owner's control at all times and not disturbing other guests.

TRASH: Please tie up your trash bags and place in trash receptacles conveniently located near each campsite.

TRAFFIC FLOW: Please observe the one-way streets (some may apply only during check-in), fire lanes/no parking zones and speed limit signs in ALL areas. Do not block campground driveways at any time, all are considered to be fire lanes—the Fire Department will be conducting fire equipment access checks all week.

DAMAGES/ALTERATIONS: You are responsible and shall pay for damage of any kind caused to any LEC campsite. Fees are minimum of \$200 per campsite.

FIRES: No fire pits of any kind allowed. Grills/smokers are allowed when used safely & not bothering other guests.

AWNINGS: Please do not leave RV awnings unattended. We suggest using awnings only when you're present to enjoy them as the Great Plains are known for wind gusts and storms.

ICE: Will be available for sale at a location to be determined—see map at check-in.

SHOWERS: Showers and portable restrooms are located in the main campground across from the back of the main performance arenas.

FOOD & BEVERAGES: Food truck(s) will be stationed not far from the Showers in the main campground with extended hours to serve the campground as well as the back of the main performance arenas and the practice/jackpot arenas. Additional food options ranging from national to local food trucks and LEC's own indoor cafes with favorites we sell year-round will be located near each performance arena and the trade show. Note that no alcohol will be sold on grounds or allowed indoors for this youth event and adults are asked to ensure responsible drinking is followed in their private campsites.

LODGING INFO

CAMPING

As a contestant, you will get priority to camp on OR near Lancaster Event Center fairgrounds so contestants and their families can be close to the NHSFR activities and fellow campers. Rates for the duration of the event (July 16 through July 26) are \$350 with electric & water in the main LEC campground and \$125 for tent/dry camping across the street to the north with no utilities (both prices with local taxes included). Reasonably priced sewer pump and water fill truck service appointments can be paid and reserved online at NHSFRLincoln.com>COMPETE>Contestant Camping Info.

We will place states/provinces/countries together as groups in the main LEC campgrounds with a certain number of campsites reserved for each group to be assigned on a priority basis by your National Director with maximum of one per contestant(s) family in most cases. Contestants are assigned specific campsites by LEC within your group's section in the order that the State Secretary lists them for us as much as possible given other factors (30 or 50 amp, size of RVs etc.). If you want to be parked by a friend, be sure to note the contestant name on your housing form - however, this is not a guarantee.

If you don't receive a campsite in the LEC main fairgrounds, there is ample Tent/Dry Camping (as well as other close by lodging options below) in a field across the street just north of the LEC fairgrounds with golf cart/vehicle/pedestrian crossing access to the fairgrounds and we will do our best to create groups by state/province here as well. You will have access to the showers, portable restrooms, food trucks etc.

RV & HOME RENTALS

You may find opportunities for available rentals through one (or more) of the following:

ALWAYS be sure to specify how many people will be occupying the unit and any special options you are looking for (Home, Room, A/C, slide-outs, length, etc.). LEC is not involved with RV rental agreements or rates that the owners set.

RV Lessees - Provide the RV owners with the Contestant's qualifying state & name. The RV owner must call LEC to get an appointment to move into your assigned campsite. Rented RVs may move onto the property beginning July 5 through July 15. Appointments are required as LEC staff must place each RV (M-F, 8-5 call 402-441-6545 option 0). We request rented RVs are placed BEFORE Contestant Check-in on July 16th.

HOTELS / CAMPGROUNDS / BED & BREAKFASTS ETC.

LEC has worked with Lincoln Convention & Visitors Bureau to secure special NHSFR discounts from a variety of local hotels. You and your family will make your own individual hotel reservation, if your State Secretary has not done so. A full local hotel listing is available at NHSFRLincoln.org>Visit>Lodging.
