

PERSONAL TRANSPORTATION POLICY

For Contestants & All Visitors on Lancaster Event Center Grounds

- No Off-Road personal vehicles will be allowed on the grounds of the Lancaster Event Center & fairgrounds during the 2020 National High School Finals Rodeo.
- **Definition of "Off-Road" Personal Vehicle:** "Off-Road Vehicle" means any self-propelled personal vehicle you bring onto the grounds that is designed or capable of traversing natural or conditioned terrain, including, but not limited to motorcycles, golf carts, dirt bikes, four and two-wheel drive all-terrain vehicles, and halftracks regardless if licensed for on-road use in any state. This does not include these type of vehicles under NHSFR Lincoln credentials of the Lancaster Event Center (LEC) or NHSRA staff or local law enforcement.
- All Rental Golf Carts, Fire Prevention, Emergency Services or any other "official" vehicle on grounds will have a NHSFR Lincoln credential to identify all vehicles on grounds.
- If you are caught in a non-credentialed Off-Road Personal Vehicle on grounds of LEC, the vehicle will immediately be placed in a locked containment area and returned at the end of the event.
- All Rental Golf Carts must be driven by persons 16 years of age or older that hold a valid driver's license and must follow rules of the road like any other vehicle.
- These rules of the road include parking without blocking others within marked parking lines, not blocking fire lanes which include campground driveways, respecting one ways, following signs for where each type of vehicle is allowed etc. Golf carts are NOT allowed off the fairgrounds nor on City of Lincoln streets except at one marked crossing area across Havelock Avenue to the Dry Camping area.
- Watch for special golf cart only paths & parking areas to make it more convenient to get around the facility including rental golf carts (& NHSFR Lincoln-credentialed staff/emergency vehicles) are only vehicles allowed access to the outdoor stalling area.
- Lancaster Event Center & NHSRA staff and volunteers and local Law Enforcement will
 enforce these rules and regulations during the entire duration of the event. Noncompliance of these rules, including being respectful with any authorities that speak with
 you about your compliance, may be dealt with by local law enforcement and may have
 an impact on your eligibility to compete in the NHSFR at the discretion of the NHSRA.
